Parts of a Book



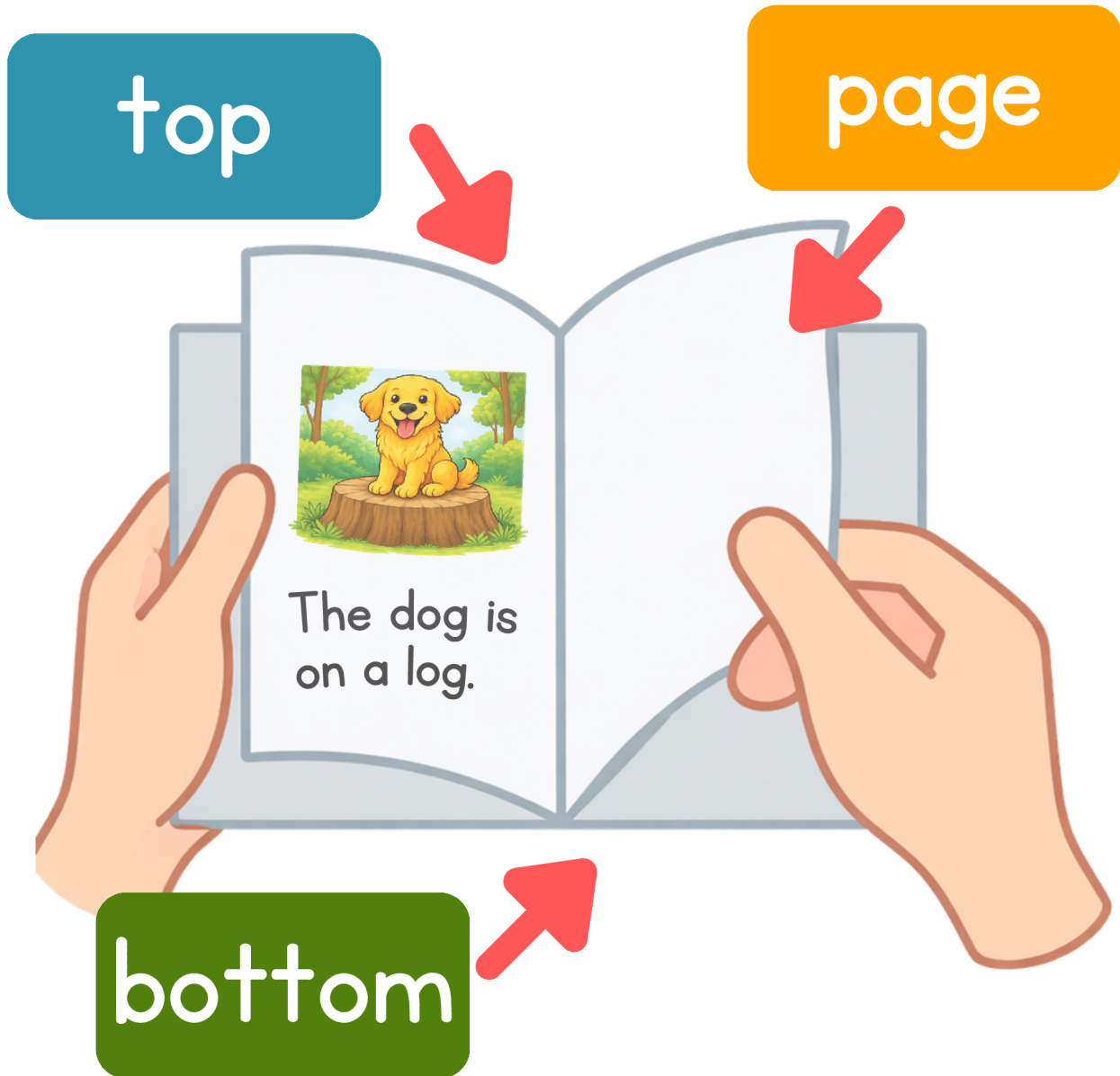
A book has a front cover, a back cover, and a spine.

Holding a Book



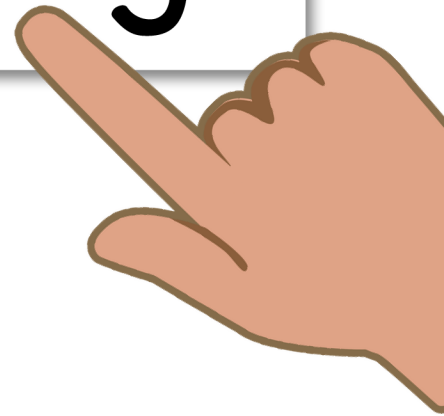
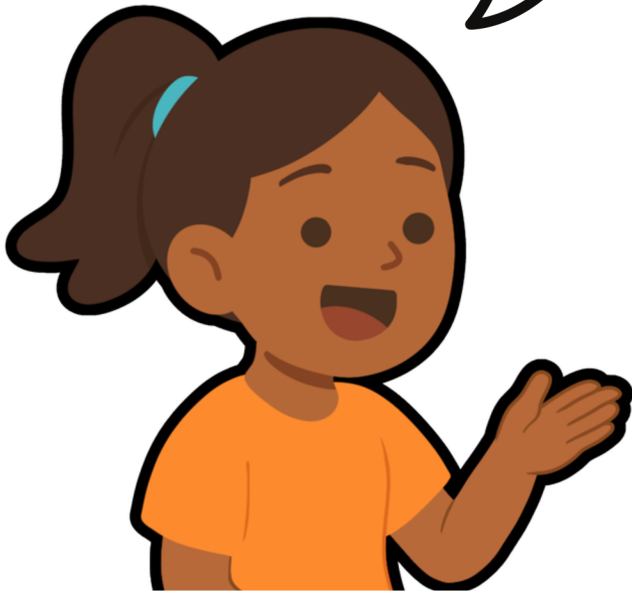
We hold the book and turn the pages one at a time.

The dog is

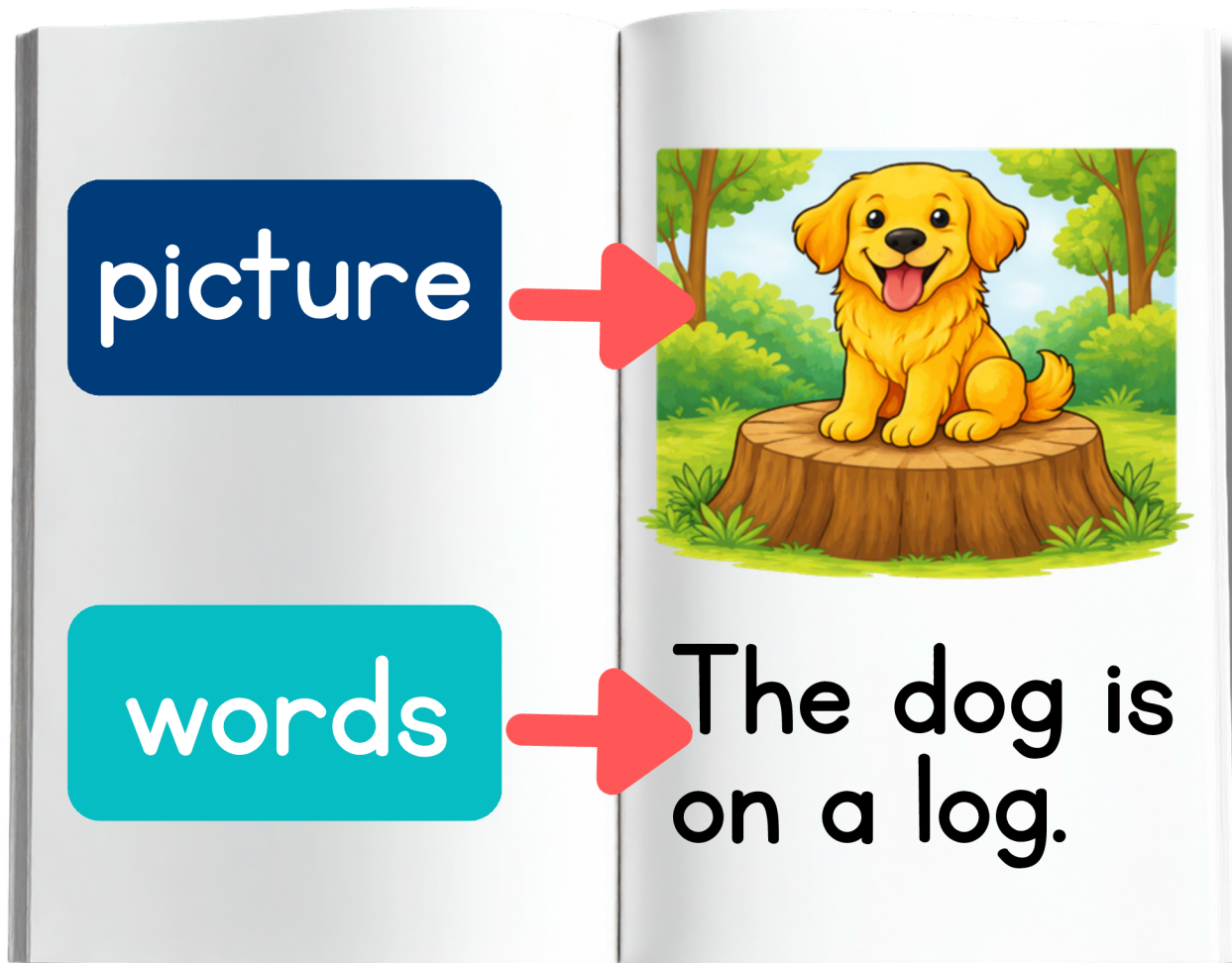


on a log.
