Literacy in the United States is in crisis; 68% of fourth graders aren't reading at grade level. Still, we see a bright future at IMSE.

Researchers at Kent State recently confirmed that students taught by IMSE OG+-trained teachers achieve differential growth in reading from fall to spring. In fact, the average Oral Reading Fluency (ORF) score for the treatment group in that study improved by nearly 10 points more than the control group score.

THE SCIENCE BEHIND READING: STRUCTURED LITERACY



Structured Literacy supports all students, especially those with learning differences. Approaches like Orton-Gillingham, grounded in the Science of Reading, emphasize repeated decoding and dictation practice to strengthen word recognition and spelling skills. Structured Literacy incorporates phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension to build the foundation necessary for reading success through both word recognition and language comprehension.



Explicit

Each new concept is clearly explained and supports learning with strategies that engage multiple senses to enhance memory.



Systematic

Instruction follows a logical scope and sequence, progressing from simple to more complex skills.



Cumulative

New concepts build on prior knowledge with frequent review to reinforce phoneme-grapheme relationships, spelling patterns, and rule generalization.



Diagnostic/ Responsive

Ongoing assessment guides instruction by monitoring progress and informing differentiation based on student needs.

Tiered Approach Meets Students Where They Are

Recognizing that no two students are the same, IMSE equips educators to address literacy instruction for different instructional tiers.

Tier 1: Core Instruction for all students


- 90 minutes of instruction per day, including 30 minutes of IMSE OG+ or Morphology+*
- Whole-class instruction or small-group instruction if additional support is needed; in the general education classroom

Tier 2: Strategic Instruction

- Minimum of 30 minutes per day at least 3 times per week in addition to core instruction
- > Small-group instruction

Tier 3: Intensive Instruction

- Minimum of 45 minutes daily in addition to core instruction
- Small-group instruction provided by a specialized teacher or interventionist
