




Freebie Directions


- Print, cut, and laminate the cards: tree cards (Latin base words) and apple cards (example words).
- Mix the cards thoroughly.
- Divide students into groups of 3-5 and give each group a shuffled set of cards.

- Next, they should sort the apple cards into piles that match the base words.
- Encourage discussion about the word meanings and connections.










